### **Holy Smoke: The Work of the Thurifer**

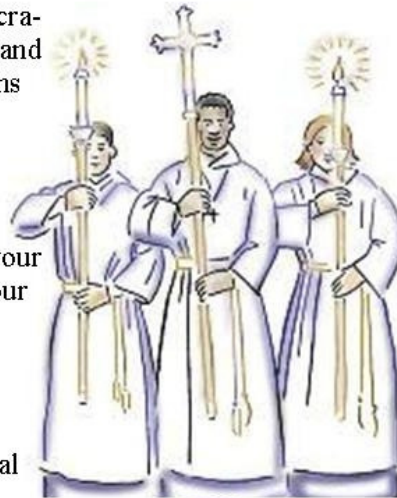
A hands-on workshop that showcases the special ministry of the thurifer. Includes review of equipment, technique, and the history of the use of incense in worship.

## **Diocese of SE Florida Acolyte Festival**

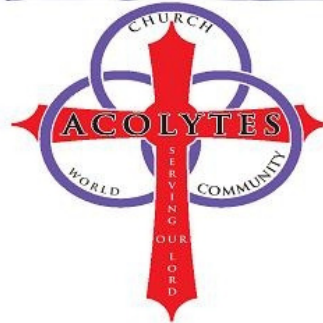

Suggested Item for St. George's

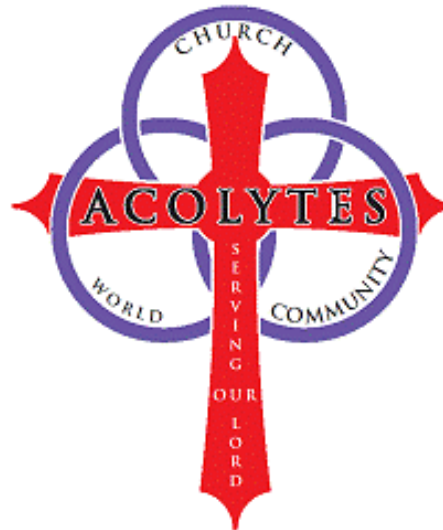
9" Plates
